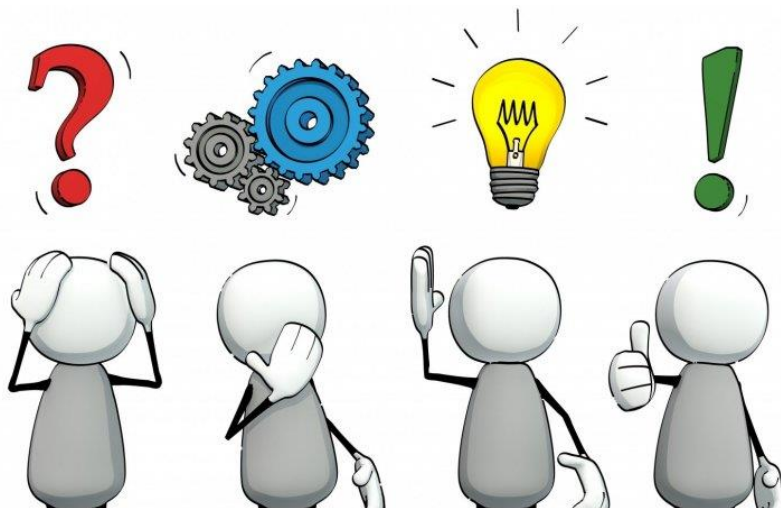
Leader: Let us share the peace with one another in sign language.

Questions to ask each other!

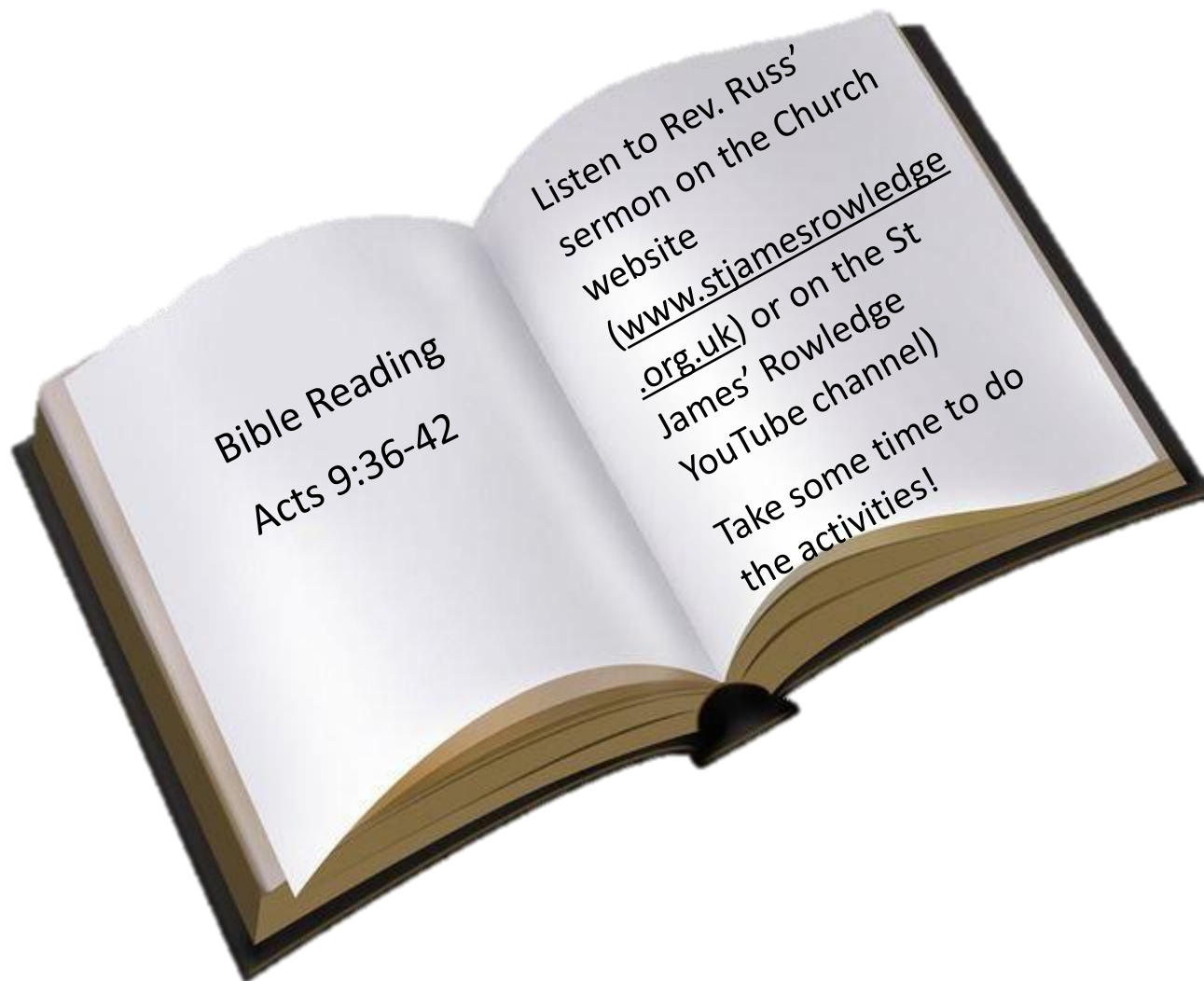
- What do you love about your family/ the people who are close to you?

Take some time to worship God with some music!



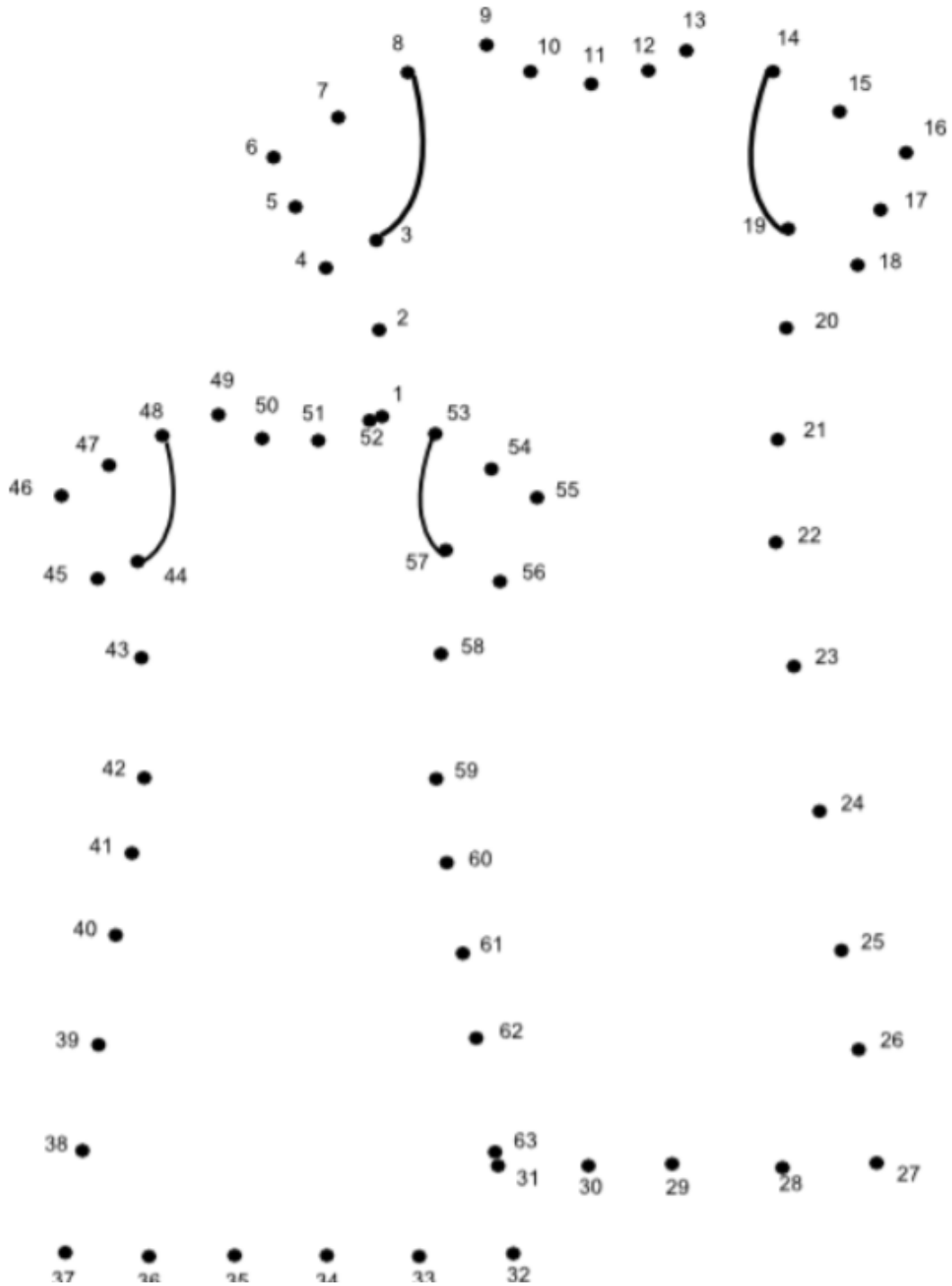
